Rev. Clark Ivey (Dean of the English Language Department)

Brother Clark is President of Compassion World Outreach, Inc., a missions ministry headquartered in Athens, Georgia. He completed undergraduate work at Kennesaw Junior College (Marietta, GA) and the University of Georgia (Athens), before completing his Master of Divinity degree at New Orleans Baptist Seminary. From 1987 – 1990 Clark served as a church planter with the Home Mission Board of the Southern Baptist Convention. Beginning in 1990, he served as pastor for a number of churches in Athens and Jefferson, Georgia. He began teaching in Christian Education in 1993 as an Instructor of Religion at the Christian College of Georgia; continued as an Adjunct Instructor of Religion at Truett-McConnell College; and became the first professor of the WorldReach Bible Institute in February of 2007.

Dr. Cash holds degrees from Berry College, Florida State University, and the University of Georgia, where he obtain his doctoral degree in Higher Education. He is the Chief Financial Officer for Bible Training Centre for Pastors in Tucker, Georgia. Dr. Cash has taught at both the secondary and post-secondary levels. Additionally, he has been on staff at Prince Avenue Baptist Church, and Truett-McConnell College. Jerry Haas

Jerry stepped away from a successful twenty-five year career in Risk Management and Finance in 1999 and joined the staff of Prince Avenue Baptist Church to fill the newly created Minister of Missions position. He is the founder and Executive Director of WorldReach Ministries, a global missions ministry that engages in evangelism, discipleship and church planting.

Jerry is an international evangelist who has preached the gospel on six of the seven continents. He has been the featured speaker at the Southern Baptist International Mission Board’s Minister of Missions Conference and spoken at numerous pastors and mission conferences around the world. In 2007, he founded WorldReach Bible Institute with campuses in the US, Romania, Peru, and soon to be opened in Argentina. He broadcasts a weekly radio program; is a featured editorial page writer for the Athens (Georgia) Banner-Herald; the head football coach for the Prince Avenue Christian Middle School football team; and a chaplain at the past eight Olympic Games.
